

# *Jesus' Exaltation and Ours*

Sermon Notes from Pastor Dennis Tuuri for the Fourth Sunday of Advent, December 18, 2011

## *First Draft Chiastic Structure of Philippians 2:6–11 (ESV) (Tuuri)*

<sup>5</sup> Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus,  
<sup>6</sup> who, being in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped,  
    <sup>7</sup> but **emptied himself**,  
        by taking the form of a servant,  
            being born in the likeness of men.  
        <sup>8</sup> And being found in **human form**,  
            he **humbled himself**  
                by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.  
<sup>9</sup> Therefore God has highly exalted him  
    and bestowed on him the name that is above every name,  
        <sup>10</sup> so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow,  
            in heaven and on earth and under the earth,  
        <sup>11</sup> and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord,  
to the glory of God the Father.

1. Positive (and Negative) Mimesis  
First Panel of Front of Order of Worship, Foot-washing, August Toplady's Rock of Ages
2. The Reversal of the Fall - Put Off Impatient Grasping for Rule  
Jesus' humiliation and service are not exceptions to God's character. Ps. 115:8
3. Put on Service and (Sometimes) Resultant Suffering

## *Philippians 2:7–8 (ESV)*

<sup>7</sup> but  
    **emptied himself**, (see Isa. 53:12)  
        [by] **taking** the form of a servant,  
            being born in the likeness of men.  
        <sup>8</sup> And being found in **human form**,  
            he **humbled himself**  
                **by becoming obedient to the point of death**,  
even death on a cross.
