5. The Attractiveness of **Truth**
6. A General, Despairing Sense of **Need**
7. Responding to Grace and **Love**
8. A Rather Vague Desire to be on the Right Side of What is **Right**, of What is from God, of What is Biblical, of What is Clean, or What Endures
