Sermon Notes for AADOL, January 19, 2014

For the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David.

## **A The Lord Knows Me – Practical Omniscience**

<sup>1</sup>O LORD, You have searched me and known me.

<sup>2</sup>You know my sitting down and my rising up;  
You understand my thought afar off.

<sup>3</sup>You comprehend my path and my lying down,  
And are acquainted with all my ways.

<sup>4</sup>For there is not a word on my tongue, But behold, O LORD, You know it altogether.

## **B The Lord Protects Me – Practical Omnipresence**

<sup>5</sup>You have hedged me behind and before, And laid Your hand upon me.

<sup>6</sup>Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; It is high, I cannot attain it. **(Stitch?)**

<sup>7</sup>Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from Your presence?

<sup>8</sup>If I ascend into heaven, You are there;

If I make my bed in hell, behold, You are there.

<sup>9</sup>If I take the wings of the morning, And dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea,

<sup>10</sup>Even there Your hand shall lead me,

And Your right hand shall hold me.

<sup>11</sup>If I say, "Surely the darkness shall fall on me,"

Even the night shall be light about me;

<sup>12</sup>Indeed, the darkness shall not hide from You,

But the night shines as the day; The darkness and the light are both alike to You.

## **C. The Lord Made Me in the Womb - Practical Omnipotence**

<sup>13</sup>For You formed my inward parts; You covered me in my mother's womb.

<sup>14</sup>I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made;

Marvelous are Your works.

And that my soul knows very well.

## **D. The Lord Made Me to Be His Tabernacle**

<sup>15</sup>My frame was not hidden from You, When I was made in secret,  
And skillfully wrought in the lowest parts of the earth.

<sup>16</sup>Your eyes saw my substance, being yet unformed.

And in Your book they all were written,

The days fashioned for me, When as yet there were none of them.

## **C'. The Lord's Thoughts Are Known to Me!**

<sup>17</sup>How precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God!

How great is the sum of them!

<sup>18</sup>If I should count them, they would be more in number than the sand;

When I awake, I am still with You.

## **B.' I Pray the Lord Will Honor His Name**

<sup>19</sup>Oh, that You would slay the wicked, O God!

Depart from me, therefore, you bloodthirsty men.

<sup>20</sup>For they speak against You wickedly; Your enemies take Your name in vain.

<sup>21</sup>Do I not hate them, O LORD, who hate You? And do I not loathe those who rise up against You?

<sup>22</sup>I hate them with perfect hatred; I count them my enemies.

## **A.' The Lord Leads Me to Know My Sins and Change**

<sup>23</sup>Search me, O God, and know my heart;

Try me, and know my anxieties;

<sup>24</sup>And see if there is any wicked way in me,

And lead me in the way everlasting.
