    - 2. Center - Walking In Resurrected Life (2:6-23; 3:1-7)
    - 3. From Malice to Patience and Forgiveness
    - 4. Lying to Singing - From Sins of Speech about Others to Singing to Others
    - 5. Unity in Christ (Personal Unity As Well) at the Center

  - 1. Admonitions Bracketed by Affirmations – 1:8, Glory, Knowledge, Life  
BUT, glory can effect safety, but safety is not glory, indeed, it can hinder our task
  - 2. Misinterpreting the Affirmation - Are You Competent to Counsel?
  - 3. To serve one other with accountability requires a fullness of goodness
  - 4. To serve one other with accountability requires a fullness of Wordness
  - 5. To serve one other with accountability requires a commitment to reciprocity
  - 6. To serve one other with accountability requires courage – both ways
